7. I did not realize the importance of this statement thinking George Hugh was fully aware of this fact.
8. I never mentioned this to anyone because it was so personal and intimate.
9. I was saddened by the comment thinking she really did not mean it.
10. I thought she was saying this because she was stressed by the whole court, jail thing.
11. I told George this in a phone call from him while he was incarcerated in this last episode.
12. I feel very reluctant to make this statement as I feel that I am in between George and his wife Azelda but it is the truth and I must speak it as I am told this is necessary.
